In Jefferson County, early voting ended with 3,353 votes cast in person. Absentee ballots are still trickling in with 2,964 requested; 2,405 have been returned & 208 have voted early instead. In all, 56.31% of voters have voted. So far, Republicans have cast 2,291 votes, Democrats 2,916, and NPA/Other 553. More republicans are voting in person v. voting by absentee ballot. I will be voting on Election Day, Nov. 3rd! How about you? Your family members?

~ Civil War and the Left's Color Revolution ~

On BlazeTV, during the month of September, Glenn Beck presented a 3-part series on the next Civil War that is very likely to breakout here in the USA immediately after the November 3 General Election, based on the Left's own plan and documents. These are not intended to instill fear, but to provide information in order to prepare you for what is coming. Each video is 48 minutes and well worth your time. Episode 1 | Civil War: The Way America Could End in 2020 | Sept. 16, 2020

We're being set up for a civil war. The Left is grooming us for an Eastern European-style revolution this election, and they're not even trying to hide it any more. The playbook for Mainstreet USA is the exact same that has been used in places like Ukraine, initiated by the same people in order to completely upend the American system. Glenn takes us through a tale of three chalkboards that will connect the dots: the Obama admin in Ukraine, the State Department's relationship with George Soros, Black Lives Matter and Antifa riots, the Great Reset, public school indoctrination, mail-in voting. It all points to something dangerous happening in November if we don't act now.

Episode 2 | Civil War: The Left's Revolution Playbook EXPOSED | Sept. 23, 2020

Revolutions rarely happen overnight. The Left started laying the groundwork for November 3, 2020, the moment Hillary Clinton had to concede the 2016 election to Donald Trump. It was always solely about getting rid of President Trump, and there is a playbook for that. In episode 1, Glenn showed you the "Seven Pillars" written by a former U.S. diplomat, which are the conditions that must be in place for a successful Color Revolution. They seem to be following the same Color Revolution playbook they used in Eastern Europe – because they are using the exact same playbook. In part two of this series, Glenn peels back the layers on the first four of these Color Revolution pillars to show you how they work and what the end goal is. And he reveals one of the architects of the playbook – a Color Revolution specialist, former ambassador, and former Obama administration official who is one of the key masterminds of this revolution. Joining Glenn is political campaign veteran and BlazeTV host Steve Deace, who says the polls that claim Biden is leading the race "are trash." We're being set up to believe that if Trump wins, in spite of the polls, it must be an invalid election.
