Essay Contest Rules

Eligibility: All Jefferson County middle school aged students (ages 11-14) currently enrolled in public or private schools or homeschooled.

Topics: These essays will be exploring the lesser-known Founding Fathers of America and other heroic people who played important roles in making America the great Republic it became.

You may pick one of the following people as the topic of your essay:

- 1. **James Armistead**: (1748-1830) "Double Agent" for the Continental Army.
- 2. **Caleb Brewster**: (September 12, 1747 February 13, 1827) Member of "Culper Spy Ring" during the Revolutionary War.
- 3. **Peter (nee Pedro) Francisco**: (July 7, 1760 January 16, 1834) At 6'6" tall and 260 pounds, he was known as the "Hercules of the American Revolution".
- 4. **Elizabeth "Betsey" Hagar**: (1750-1843) A remarkably talented and hardworking woman who understood patriotism at the grass roots level.
- 5. **Dr. Benjamin Rush**: (January 4, 1746 April 19, 1813) A man who slept little and accomplished so much; for example, he earned the title "Father of American Medicine".
- 6. **Deborah Sampson (Gannett)**: (December 17, 1760 April 29, 1827) A lady soldier in disguise in the Revolutionary War.
- 7. **General Artemus Ward**: (November 26, 1727 October 28, 1800) First Commander in Chief of the American Revolution.
- 8. **Dr. Joseph Warren**: (June 11, 1741 June 17, 1775) His extraordinary and flamboyantly lived life as a Boston doctor, spy, patriot, orator, graverobber and more, was cut short when he was killed at the Battle of Bunker Hill.
- 9. **John Woolman**: (October 19, 1720 October 7, 1772) This humble Quaker helped to lay the foundation for a Godly America.

Answer each of the following questions about your chosen person:

- What are the main biographical facts about the person's life and family? Provide a description of key events in his/her childhood that may have shaped their character.
- 2. What are the main accomplishments in this person's life that contributed to America's founding and development?

- 3. How does this person's life inspire you to become an involved citizen?
- 4. After knowing about this person's life, imagine that you are living at the same time as this person. If you could, what kind of life would you choose to live in those times? Include where you would live, the type of family you would have, and the types of work you would do?

Requirements:

- 1. The essay is to be typed using 14-point font, and double spaced. The essay should be between 750-850 words. Do not include any photos or images.
- The essay must have a bibliography listing references utilized, including a list of any internet resources. If internet resources are used, add the electronic address (URL) used to access the document.
- 3. A separate cover sheet (see form attached to this announcement) must accompany the essay.
- 4. Do not include your name or the school's name on any of the pages of the essay.

Criteria for Judging: The essays will be judged on quality of research, accuracy, writing ability, and grammar.

Due Date: Your essay must be post marked no later than April 30, 2021.
