President's Message

In the May Newsletter, I highlighted a *few* key take-aways from **Karen** and **Susan's** April presentations. In scripture, we are told, **DO NOT FEAR, have faith.** How many churches (perhaps one you attend) have conceded much of what they did prior to Covid-19, for most, if not all, of the past 12+ months? Three years ago, several of us from my church tried to get our church leadership to be proactive in preparation for a possible active shooter situation. We were told, *"We should have faith."* Well, what happened to people's faith during Covid? Especially the church leaders? It was consumed by **FEAR.** From the beginning, fear has always been used to control people.

Two weeks ago, my church designated a 'mask optional section' at the early service for those not wanting to wear masks. A friend, on the Emergency Action Committee, sent word home with my son a few days ago of this new policy, since I've not attended in person church since March of last year, due to the mask mandate. She also said, *"I guess your mom hasn't been vaccinated either, so maybe she can sit at a distance."* I just shook my head, because for the past several weeks I've heard a number of stories of concerns of unjabbed persons being around those having the injection(s) having varying degrees of adverse reactions that cannot be explained otherwise. If one consented to the injection, since they believed it would protect them, why do so many fear those who didn't get a shot?

~ Propaganda/Fake News vs. Just the Facts (Part Two) ~

Excerpts below from Lex Greene's article [Surrender by Fear of a Cold](#). (**Emphasis** mine!)
