## Covid Update:

★ The expected FDA "<u>approval letter</u>" for the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine was issued on Aug 23, and the Biden Administration immediately called on companies to require vaccination. "Full approval" removes the legal impediment that <u>vaccines only available under an Emergency Use Authorization</u> (EUA) must be voluntary and cannot be mandated. Read <u>AAPS Statement on FDA's "Approval Decision" on Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 Vaccine</u>. An **updated version** (8/28/21) of the popular booklet by the Association of American Physicians and Surgeons (AAPS), <u>A Guide to Home-Based COVID</u> <u>Treatment</u>, is now available and can be downloaded free from <u>http://covidpatientguide.com</u>. [The July Newsletter referenced the prior version, released January, when no "vaccines" were available.]
