THE REMAKING OF AMERICA

We are in the midst of one of the most radical revolutions in American history. It is as far-reaching and dangerous as the turbulent years of the 1850s and 1860s or the 1930s. Every aspect of American life and culture is under assault, including the very processes by which we govern ourselves, and the manner in which we live.

If I said 10 years ago that in the future... nobody would believe it:

- Biological men compete in women's sports.
- Saying there are only two genders can get you fired.
- 2.3 million people illegally enter the country each year.
- Month-long elections are 70% mail-in ballots.
- BLM and Antifa destroyed neighborhoods for 120 days, causing \$2 billion in damage, mostly going unpunished.
- The FBI, DOJ, and the corporate media framed Donald Trump as a Russian agent to rig the 2016 election.
- The CIA and the corporate media claimed that Hunter Biden's laptop was "Russian disinformation" to rig the 2020 election.

Prior to finalizing this newsletter, I checked the J.C. SOE website and the breakdown shown is: **4,175 REP** + **4,162 DEM** + **1,284 Other** (NP+MP) = **9,621 Total**, the same total number of voters as the Div. of Elections showed at the end of July (see above), which continues to show the steady gain of REP voters and loss of DEM voters as has been the case for the past 5 years. ■
