~ 2023 American Valor Dinner Recap & Acknowledgements ~



A lot of time (volunteer hours) goes into facilitating this big event every other year. Unfortunately, this year I did not have a co-organizer, although several attending for their first time have said they will definitely help next time, and I will remember who you are!

It all began in May with deciding on the date and venue, then booking a speaker, which happened this year in less than 24 hours of contact! Updating our flyers and sponsor forms to send to past and potential new sponsors, which is what fuels the entire event. Adding a club event page to our website. In July, contacting and arranging for the caterer (everyone said "the food was excellent"). And booking a room for the speaker at one of our B&B's (challenging with it being a home FSU v Miami game weekend.)

Sponsor recruitment began in August, then follow-up and more follow-up with solicited sponsors, as needed. In all we had 30 sponsors, 12 new! I want to thank several members who helped with obtaining sponsors: **Beth Young** (3), **Gretchen Wallace** (2), and **Karen Knox** (1 big one!). Silent Auction donations ends up being very easy, you just have to ask, and then follow up when it's time to pick up the item. This is a good way to get additional sponsors of the event. In all, we had 23 items or gift certificates ranging from \$10 to \$125 in value, a total value of \$1,246, raising \$710, with two going for face value and two for over the value! Thank you to **Karen Knox** for handling the auction! And these members for their contributions: **Diana Mulhearn** (2), **Gretchen Wallace** (3), and **Beth Young**. The complete list of those donating items to the silent auction were in the November Newsletter.

I ordered 25 copies of T-Bone's book, *GROUNDED AND CURED*, to have available for sale and for him to autograph, which sold out soon after he finished speaking (\$81.50 profit). There was **merchandise** on display and thanks to **Gretchen Wallace**, **Beth Young** and **Abby McGehee** for handling sales, \$175.

Ongoing was updating the list off sponsors, list of silent auction participants and preparing bid sheets, the event program, and confirming veterans to fill the sponsored seats, which turns out to be the most time-consuming part of the event. Making sponsor signs and table center pieces utilizing KFRW decorations, finalizing a seating chart based on sponsors and guests; and then have everything ready!

A special thanks of gratitude to Lynn McGrady for printing and folding the event programs. Brannan Salter and Lynn Stafford for arranging the tables and chairs Wednesday evening. Annaliese Mincy for setting up the projector and working with MOH for mic and sound. The final task was preparing, printing, and mailing thank you letters to all sponsors of the event and silent auction, 49 in all! Whew!
