# ~ KFRW Watermelon Festival Recap ~

For set up, **Lynn Stafford** and **Abby McGehee**. Those who

helped at the booth on Friday were: Abby McGehee, Beth Young, Tracy & Dusty Boyce, Jacquie Arbogast, and Lynn McGrady, who along with Brannan Salter helped close up the tent for the night by dark! On Saturday: Diana Rodriguez & Lynn S. opened up the booth, with help from Don Ledbury, and after the parade Lynn Wojciechowski and Tracy Boyce and Dusty Boyce, who also helped with take down.

KFRW had a great location, right on the end of the E. Dogwood St row of booths at the corner of N. Cherry St, so open on two sides for entry into the booth. The Pop-



Up tent we purchased in 2022 proved a great asset again this year. Fortunately, we had no rain this year, just the extreme heat to contend with. When not helping visitors in the booth, we were able to seek shade under a Crepe Myrtle tree and utilized a fan to keep the air circulating.

After we were set up on Friday, **Beth Young** went to the REC Campaign Headquarters (150-170 N. Jefferson) and other local shops leaving a supply of **Do No Harm Florida** Vote No on Amendment 4 cards. *Check with Beth to see where a supply of cards has been left.* 

Foot traffic was a little less again this year, most likely due to the high temps. We made \$778 from merchandise sales and a "keep the change" donation. In all, we sold: Bumper Stickers, Magnets, Buttons, Flags, Card Cases, Caps, Hats, Mark Levin donated books, lapel pins, and a Cowboy Hat, Trump Golf Balls, Visor, Scarf, and Earrings. The website has been updated removing any items no longer available; please share links with your friends to help make a difference in 2024.

**WF Parade**: Members represented KFRW in the parade. I especially want to thank **Tracy Boyce** for decorating the float at her home on Friday, **Dotty McPherson** for bringing Ginny, those riding



on the float and kept walkers in supply of give-a-ways (Robin Frutig, Abby McGehee & Dotty), and the walkers, Tracy & Dusty Boyce carrying the banner, Janis Morrow, Gretchen Wallace, Lynn Wojciechowski, Andrew Kang, and Ernie Morrow, who provided the truck and trailer, and drove "slow" to the parade spot, which was an ordeal due to the blocked streets for the 5k walk/run route, and during the parade. The walkers passed out: red-white-blue beads and bracelets, "God Bless America" and patriotic smiley face buttons to the children and Do No Harm Vote No on Amendment 4 cards to the adults along the parade route.
